The new Whangārei Civic Centre, Te Iwitahi, brings to Whangārei a central hub for its civic facilities and services.

Te Iwitahi is the product of the Whangārei Council's partnerships with local Hapu, community advisory groups, and local businesses and organisations. This community-owned facility marks the first time in more than 30 years that Whangārei has had a central hub for its civic facilities and services. Universal design principles, sustainability and an integrated cultural narrative are at the core of the building's design
